Hello Lamb of God,

Art Werfelmann is the pastor emeritus at Lamb of God. Emeritus is a Greek word which means "We don't pay his insurance, but he still works for us." Something like that anyway, my Greek is pretty rusty. Art retired from ministry 10 years ago. Then he showed up at our church about the same time Jerry Scansen, the interim pastor, encountered significant health problems. Art stepped in full-time until I was called there about 6 months later. After that, Art was kind enough to fill in for me about once a quarter. There's no reason you should know this, but it's hard to find LCMS pastors who are comfortable stepping in to do worship the way we do it. Art was a great help to me.

Some of you might remember that after Grace Lutheran had their pastor removed, they asked Art to fill in there temporarily while they called someone else. Three years later, Art had to tell them he was done with that "temporary" gig. Again, I was glad to have him back. So was Todd Roeske, the pastor at Peace in Monroe. Todd does worship in a similar style and no doubt finds it hard to find a capable replacement when he travels. Art frequently stepped in to help over there too.

A couple of weeks ago at our Tuesday pastor lunch, Art told us he was going to retire, like really retire. He's scheduled to preach for me October 13 & he said that would be his last sermon. Now part of me thinks, "But what will I do?" (Sometimes I like to make things about me) But the truth is that I have friends younger than me who are retired and don't do anything. Art is turning 80 and he has put in nearly two full lifetimes of career. He has served us, served me, and more importantly served God well and faithfully. He has more than earned a retirement.

In the military, we frequently had people separate before retirement. The tendency I noticed was to say "Good luck" to those who were "meh" kind of workers, while utilizing guilt and/or scare tactics to coerce the good workers to stay. I swore I would never do that. So, I choked back my selfish desires and thanked him for his help to me over the last 10 years. I would encourage you to do the same. In fact, if you have the chance, thank his wife Kris as well. Being married to a pastor is no piece of cake. I know plenty of men

Greetings in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

College Evangelique le Lutherien de
Ouanaminthe (CELO) is the main school operated by Rev. Daniel Paul's ministry--Preschool through Filo (Final class, 13th grade). Rev.
Paul commented, "This year will be our second year of having a Filo class, and we have eleven students, nine of whom are children living in the girls and boys homes." (Note: Haiti has standardized testing to advance in classes and only a small percentage ever make it to the Filo class.) They will be having a celebration dinner and gathering this Sunday for the students to motivate them as they enter their final year of school.

CELO also has been playing in soccer competitions. Rev. Paul reported, "We have two competitions left. This Saturday we will play the Roman Catholic team. This will be difficult because they have mature players who are

already on the national team." When I was in Haiti, I went to watch a soccer competition with the CELO team, composed of 14-17 year olds, competing with a team of 18-24 year olds. CELO competed well but did not win that time.

I inquired about some information I had gathered about the atmosphere of the Dominican Republic and Haiti. The report stated that from January-August of 2023, 94,000 Haitians were returned to Haiti. This is an intense issue for Ouanaminthe, since it is right on the border. Rev. Paul said, "I think there were more than that, and they are not only returned, but some are being killed." We continue to pray for Interim Prime Minister Gary Conille as efforts are being pursued to have more political stability and deal rightly with all the other issues of that society. God's peace,

Greetings,

I have attached photos from a celebration for eleven students who are entering their final year of school at College Evanglique le Lutherien de Ouanaminthe (CELO: the school operated by Rev. Daniel Paul's ministry). Of the eleven students, nine of them are children from La Maison des Agneaux de Dieu Orphelinat (MADO) and two are from the community. In the Haitian education process, students must show proficiency to move forward in classes, with few ever making it to the final year that they call FILO. This is the second time in CELO's history to have a FILO class. Hence the opportunity to celebrate with worship, dinner, and pictures. You can also see a video of the FILO worship service at nehlm.org.

Concerning agricultural pursuits, Rev. Paul reported, "We are working in the gardens every day. Many of the boys and girls are involved with the work. Wilson is organizing a

project to have honey. We are trying to obtain trees with good flowers or obtain land with those trees." We are thankful for their steady effort to provide food.

Rev. Paul's daughters Sarai and Whitney, who are living with us in La Grande, will begin classes Monday, September 23rd. There is a certain level of excitement and nervousness with this; however, they seem to be ready for the adventure.
