THE CONNECTION

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." Colossians 3:16

Happy Thanksgiving Lamb of God,

The Psalms are full of thanks. "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name." (Psalm 100:4) "Praise the Lord. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." (Psalm 106:1) The word "thanks" is used 22 times in psalms alone.

Likewise, "thanks" is found all over the Epistles. "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thessalonians 5:18) "But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15:57) In Paul's letter and the general epistles it pops up a whopping 38 times.

The word "thanks" is, however conspicuously sparse in the Gospels. Jesus talks about the kingdom of God all the time. He talks about money and forgiveness until His countercultural message is clear. But every Thanksgiving the lectionary has the same gospel reading: the 10 lepers. It's a great story, but it leaves us wondering if that's the only time Jesus addressed the topic of gratitude. Didn't He think it was important?

One thing we should keep in mind is that the Gospel accounts are not exhaustive records of Jesus' ministry. They are highly edited narratives, shaped by the specific point or points the author is trying to make. Jesus might have taught many lessons on the subject that simply didn't fit the theme of these four accounts.

The other thing to keep in mind is that there are different ways to teach a thing. Jesus might, for instance, sit down and say "Blessed are the thankful, for they will spend less time stressing over what they don't have, and more time enjoying what they do." Maybe He did. But He also might have taught gratitude primarily by example.

All four gospel accounts include Jesus' miraculous feeding of the 5.,000. All four also include Jesus giving thanks for the loaves and fishes. That's understandable. It's the kind of thing we should be thankful for. But of the three accounts that include the Last Supper, all three include Jesus giving thanks for the bread and the wine. On the precipice of His own torture and death, Jesus pauses to give thanks. He lived a life of profound gratitude. Jesus never seems to have lost sight of what the Father gave, nor did He lose appreciation (continued on p. 3)

News From NEHLM—Haiti Updates (November 13, 2024)

November 13, 2024

Greetings in the Name of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Amen.

On October 25th, the northeast (nord est) section of Ouanaminthe was impacted by heavy rain. Two photos are attached of the Ouanaminthe area showing some issues involved. Rev. Paul commented, "The gardens are struggling with the water sitting in them. We do not have a way to drain them. We will lose some of the plants in these garden areas." He also commented about canals and the Massacre River (which runs about a 1/4 mile from the orphanages) that overflowed and caused problems. As you can see in one photo, someone's vehicle was in a very unfortunate situation. Rev. Paul reported that the school ground and the girls' and boys' home did not have any damage, though there was some water sitting around in low areas. There is some travel taking place in many of the northern areas of Haiti. Traveling is able to be done by Haitians and there are people from outside the country also traveling safely in many areas. This is a wonderful sign of stability. We pray for continued stability of the Haitian political system.

College classes have started for our houseguests from Rev. Paul's family. Sarai is excelling in her second year of college. Whitney is trying to navigate the challenges of the language ("all the instructions are in English"). We are encouraging them to strive at doing their best in the opportunity that is before them. They did presentations at Peace LCMS in Selah, Washington, and at Bethlehem LCMS in Yakima, Washington, Sunday, November 3rd. Nord Est Haiti Lutheran Mission (NEHLM) strives to promote this ministry in order to help support the proclamation of God's Word, education of youth, and care for people.

Rev. Paul reported that "International Children's Day" on November 20th is something that the agency overseeing children's homes (EBERS) strongly encourages him to celebrate. There is regularly a special meal and lessons to support, protect, and encourage the youth will be presented. Wednesday is a regular school day. Rev. Paul commented, "We will have the celebration on Saturday, November 23rd, with the meal and stuff. On Wednesday, this day will be recognized in school, but it would be too much for the children to have the celebration on a school day."

(FYI: This children's recognition day is a United Nations day that has been recognized since 1959 when the United Nation General Assembly adopted the Declaration of the Rights of Children. Other names for this day are World Children's Day and Universal Children's Day. I put International Children's Day in quotation marks because some areas have June 1st being a day by that name.)
