"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." Colossians 3:16

Merry Christmas Lamb of God,

In A Charlie Brown Christmas, a discouraged, confused, and dejected Charlie Brown asks, "Isn't there anyone who knows what Christmas is all about?" Linus answers him by quoting Luke 2:8-14, the announcement of Jesus birth to the shepherds.

And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

The shepherds, living outside of Bethlehem, were probably watching over the sheep used in temple sacrifice just a few miles away. This is ironic, since the shepherds themselves lived in a state of perpetual uncleanness. It was just a function of their jobs. The process of caring for the sheep used for sacrifice, kept them in a state which made them unpresentable in the temple. They provided the means for others to become right with God, but could not become righteous themselves since sacrifice was the only way available to atone for their sins.

The appearance of an angel is enough to frighten anyone, but a supernatural messenger of God

appearing when you know you are on His wrong side must have been terrifying. No wonder the angel's first words are "Do not be afraid."

These words are more than a desire for the shepherds to be quiet and listen. The angel wants them to know they don't need to be afraid of God anymore. Ever. God had returned to earth, but not to judge. He had come to His people, but not as a king. He had come to lead them, but not to conquer. He had come as the lowliest of them to lead them back to Himself. He first announced His arrival to those who society cast off.
