away. When people tried to make Him king by force, He just slipped away.

Not only were His goals suspect, Jesus' methods made no sense. As any demagogue will tell you, the easiest way to gain a following is to pick out an unpopular group and start bashing them. There were plenty of potential targets: Romans, tax collectors and "sinners." If you wanted so low hanging fruit, there was always the Samaritans. But Jesus not only refrained from calling these people out, He actually engaged with them, healed them, befriended them.

"Come follow Me. Stop acquiring wealth and power, look to the well-being of people who don't like you and forgive people who treat you like garbage." How did that message gain a following? I could almost see how this might make sense if Jesus was just a pawn, manipulated by Peter, Paul and other followers, deified after His death. But they seem to have followed His lead, rejecting wealth, power and multiple romantic partners. Maybe they weren't as extreme as Jesus, but they certainly didn't leverage their position to their advantage. Even cult leaders know how to do that!

At face value, the whole proposition makes no sense. Trust in His promise for eternal life? Okay, that's a huge reward for very little cost. But the promise is given by someone who avoided everything most of us want in this world, who got humiliated and executed in the most brutal way available for His trouble. I can honestly only think of one reason this new religion stuck around for the first 300 years. It's true.

Jesus didn't just show us a better way to live. Lots of religions do that. Nor did He promise that if we followed certain rules, one day we would be rewarded when we die. Nearly every religion does that. Jesus removed our sin. If there's another religion that claims that, I haven't heard of it. His promise doesn't just start one day when you die and go to heaven; it begins now. He enables us to know the One who made us, gives us meaning and purpose, loves us with reckless abandon. Not a myth, not a story invented by someone who would profit from it. Just truth.

NEWS FROM NEHLM

Nord Est Haiti Lutheran Mission

Greetings, February 25, 2025

Rev. Paul reported that, "Politics in Port au Prince continu saddened by the death of one of the Kenyan policemen by a gang north of Port au Prince near Gonaives. We are praying for God to protect them all." The Kenyan police were sent as a "peace keeping" unit in the summer of 2024. There are many issues involved in trying to determine their effectiveness. It has historically been difficult for outside military forces to be effective.

Djeferson is the boy who had the head injury while helping transport some wood. Rev. Paul said, "Djeferson is doing well. He has returned to school. He does continue to get new bandages on his wounds every two days." Another health concern is for a pastor, Rev. Paul Touloute, who is in the hospital with respiratory concerns. Rev. Touloute attended Concordia Theological Seminary with Rev. Paul and myself. He resides in Les Ceyes, southern Haiti.

I am planning a trip to visit Rev. Paul's ministry this May and have one other participant going with me. The travel concerns are minimal in north east Haiti. A member of NEHLM attempts to visit at least every other year.

She is pursuing getting a work visa to stay in the Dominican Republic to be able to help support the four other ladies who are continuing their studies. Lord willing, I will have two other graduations to share with you later this year.

I have scheduled a trip to visit La Maison des Agneaux de Dieu Orphelinat (The House of the Lambs of God Orphanage) in May 2025. I have one other person going with me at this time. Rev. Paul is excited for host guests and has several things planned for us. We will have some luggage space to take cards, letters, or an item about the size of a card. 
