

#### ZION LUTHERAN SCHOOL-SCHOOL BOARD UPDATE

Hello,

Zion Lutheran School Board met tonight.

Enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year is currently at 289 students with the possibility of more students enrolling in the next several months.

The school is transitioning from Sycamore Education to FACTS as their School Management Software.

Lamb of God LCMS has done a lot of work on drainage in the back field: they are laying drain fields and hop to have this stage of work completed

by June. Next would be going to the County to ask, in general terms, if we could transition from portables to new permanent structures with some modifications to our existing Conditional Use Permit.

Teachers and students are in the home stretch for this school year. It's been a great year!

# NEWSFROM NEHLM

Nord Est Haiti Lutheran Mission

\*\*There was not a NEHLM update sent in May as of this publication. So here is one from March that was missed. Also, on June 16<sup>th</sup>, there will be a presentation about NEHLM at the school. More details about that will be sent out when it becomes available.

Greetings, March 27, 2025

Rev. Paul reports, "We are doing well, by the grace of God!"

In the schools he is dealing with some extra courses that are taking several hours each week. I think these courses are ones for which they have yet to obtain a teacher, so he is filling in for the time being.

I inquired about services for the Lenten season, and he responded, "We always have our Wednesday and Friday services along with our two nights a month with an overnight worship." (I went to an overnight Service for about two hours several years ago—quite an experience with lots of prayers and singing.) "During Lent, we adjust the theme to fit a Lenten emphasis." They also had a "Revival" last Sunday, inviting two of the school classes to worship with them. Rev. Paul shared, "It was crowded with many people standing outside." Nord Est Haiti Lutheran Mission (NEHLM) continues to "walk with" them to pursue a larger worship facility.

Rev. Paul's daughters, Whiney and Sarai, who are living in our house, have completed their winter quarter and are on a Spring Break trip with the university to visit areas along the west coast of the USA.

I continue to prepare for our trip this May and would be able to take letters to children that some of you are sponsoring.


